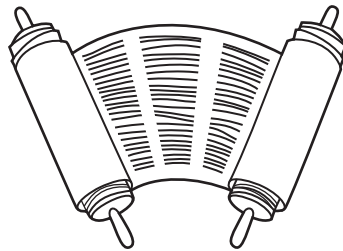
Section C – Judaism
