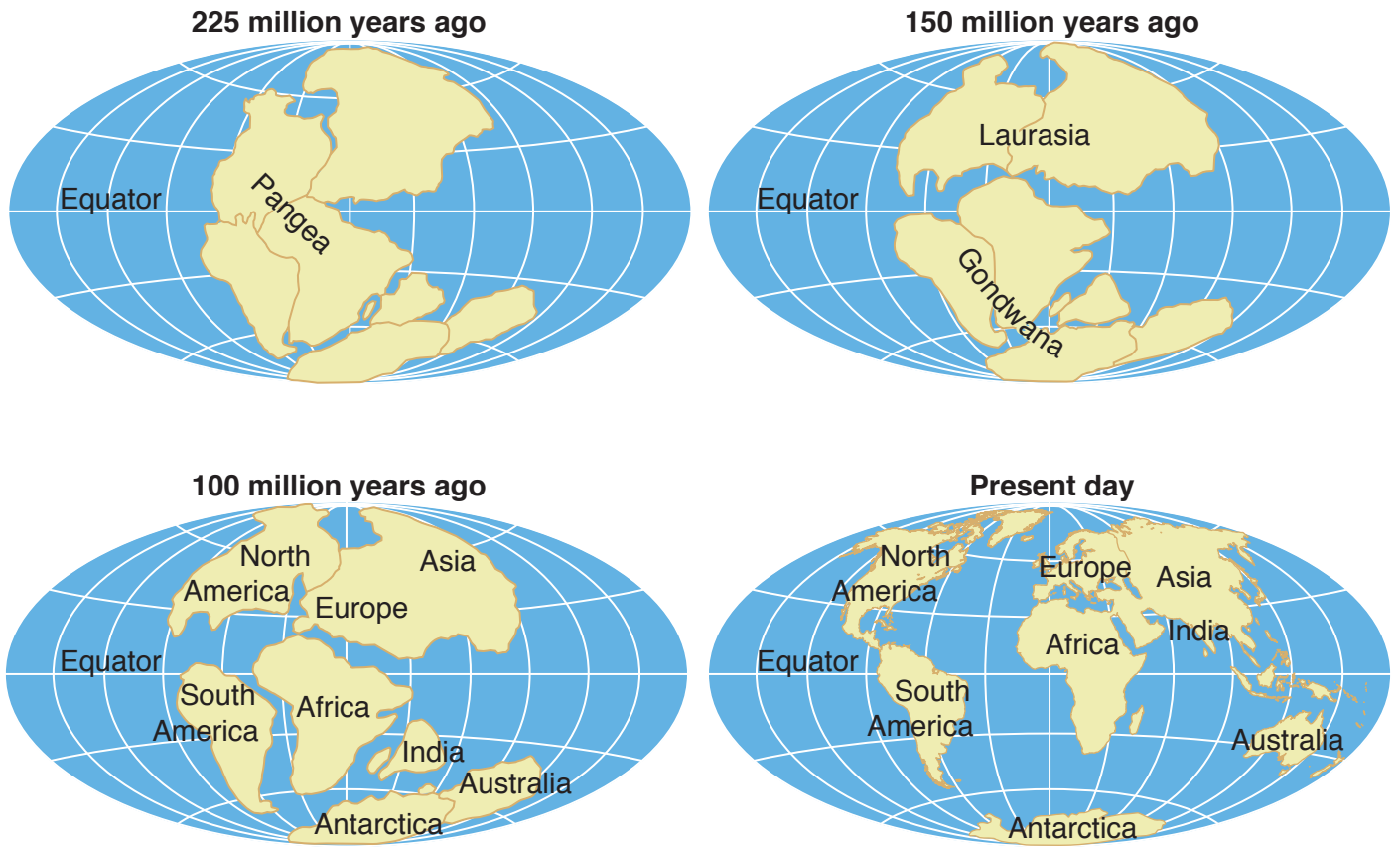

Hail probability in the USA for 24 May based on records from 1982 to 2011

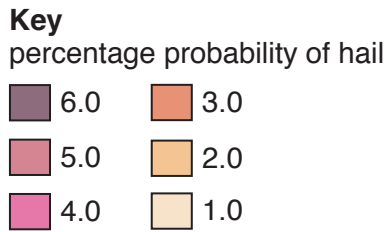
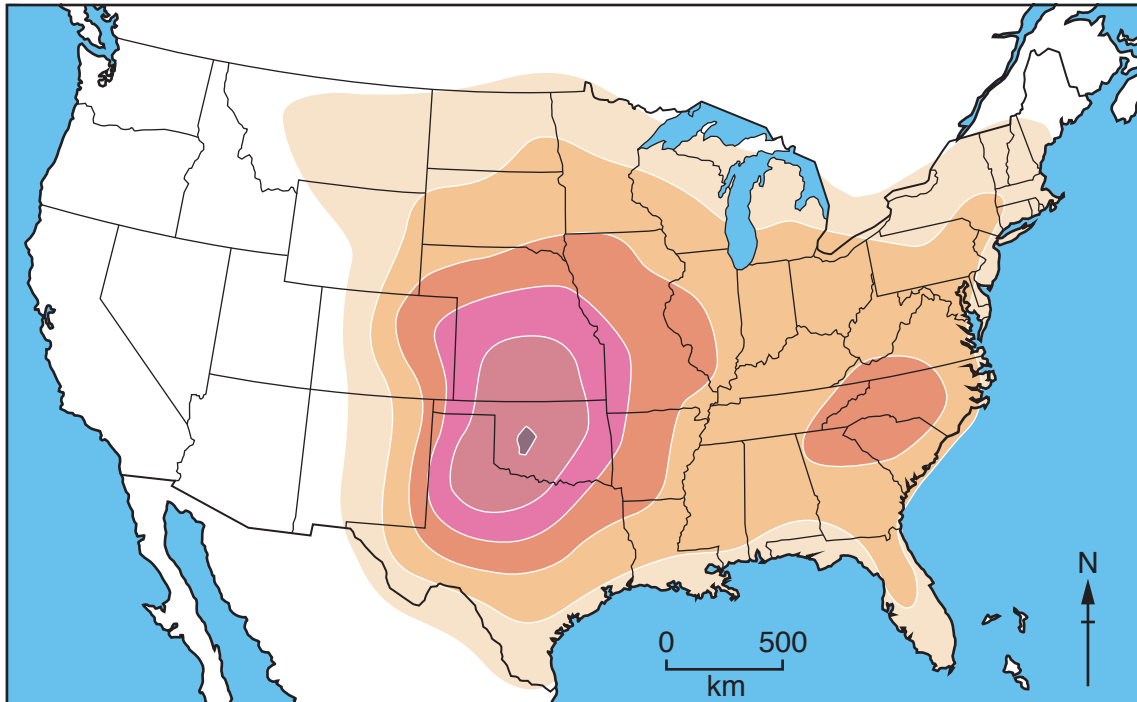

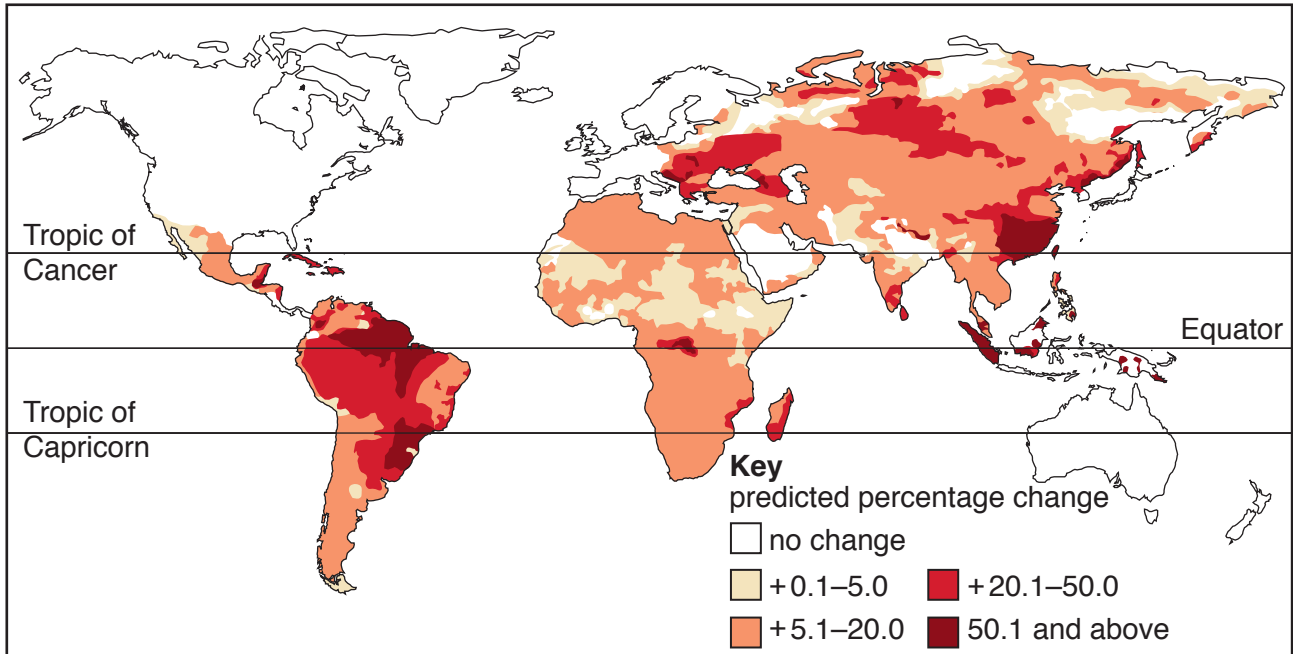
The states of the USA

Types of recorded crime committed in England and Wales in February 2016

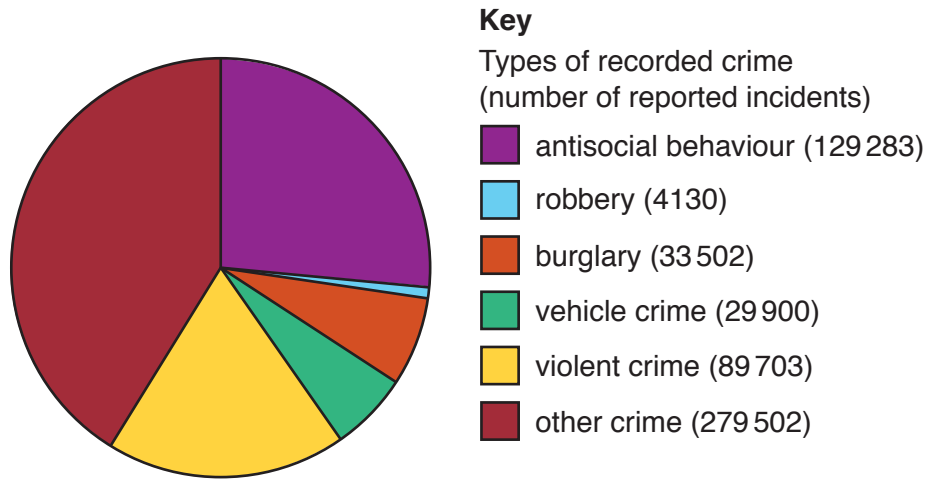

Types of recorded crime committed in Northern Ireland in February 2016

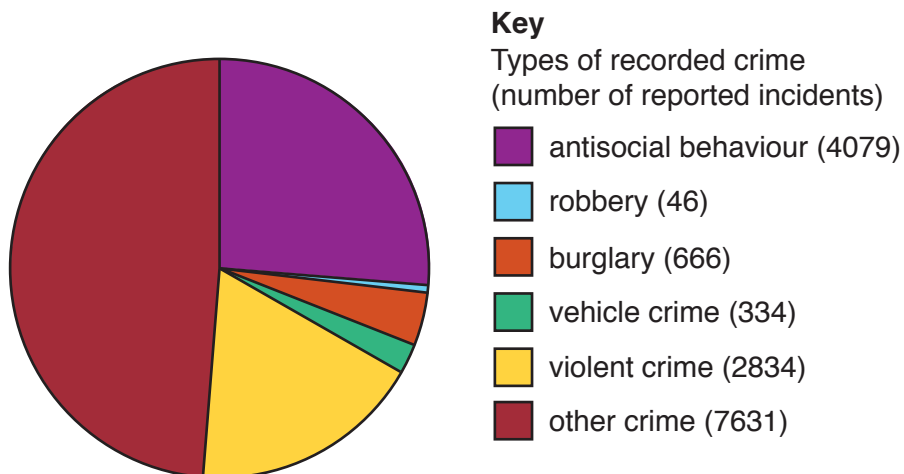

Risk of emergence of an influenza outbreak

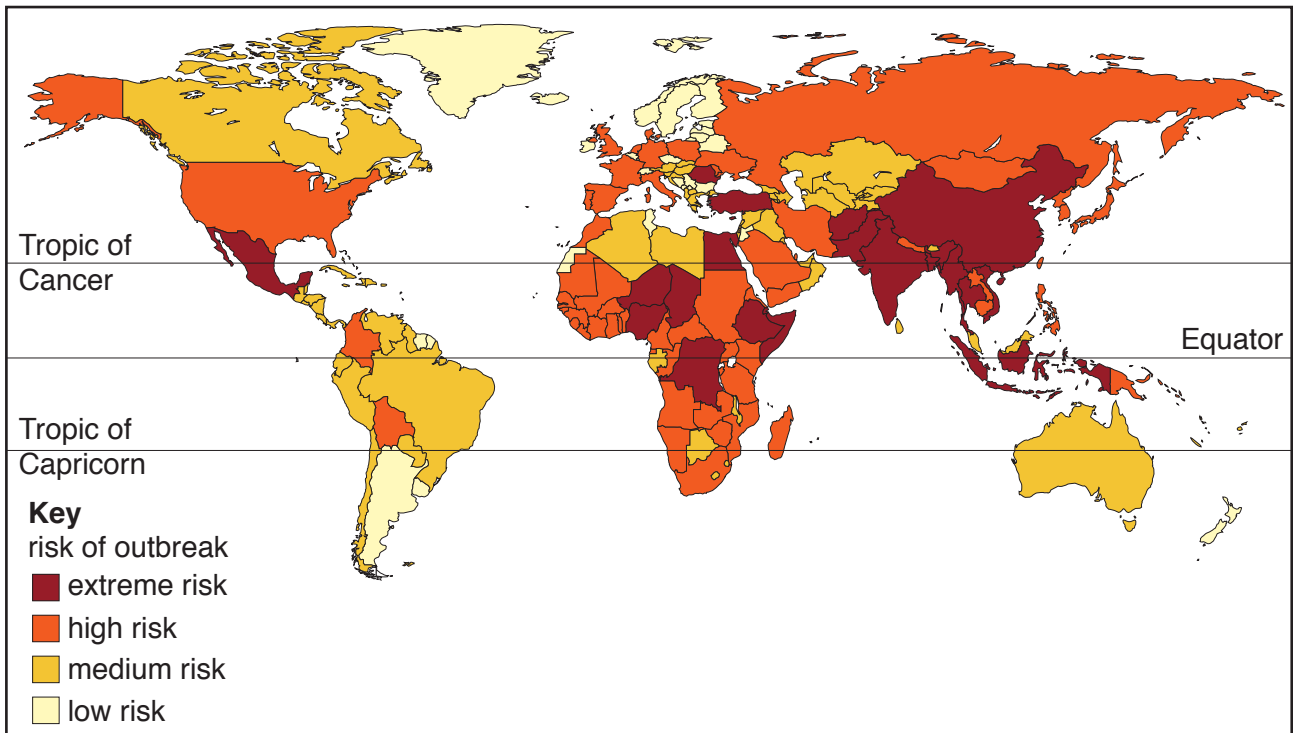
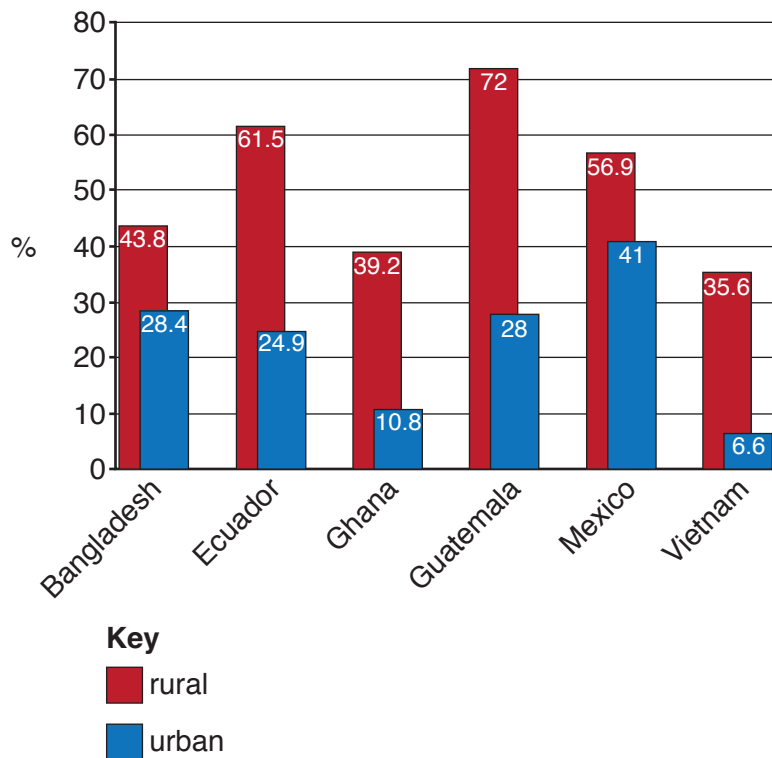
